Actually these might be Panasonic connectors. AXE526124 looks really similar (Digikey [255-3193-1-ND](#))

It looks like Panasonic has a few 0.4mm families that interconnect. I have to do a detailed analysis of the different families to see if there something "hidden" that would prevent them from interoperating. <http://pewa.panasonic.com/components/connectors/narrow-pitch-board-to-fpc-connectors/a4f>, but A4S and F4/F4S all look compatible.
